

Cape Buffalo has asked the League to clarify for all APA members certain information regarding TABC rules and regulations as they relate to business operations at Cape Buffalo.

Because APA League players are customers of the host location once they enter that location, the League cannot make exceptions to rules governed by any host location or other legal entities, such as TABC. All customers of the location are expected to abide by all that host location's rules and their expectations of acceptable behavior. The League, as a business partner with our host locations, gives total support to the host locations in enforcing their individual and specific requirements within their individual establishment.

**The side doors at Cape Buffalo are for emergency purposes only.** These doors are not to be opened to allow anyone to go outside to smoke, or to allow anyone to exit or enter, or to sneak in under-aged players, to name a few examples of recent use.

Cape Buffalo has asked many individual players in the past to not exit/enter through these doors, but it still continues to occur. This is both a liability issue and a legal issue for Cape Buffalo.

Effective immediately, ANY LEAGUE PLAYER(S) WHO OPENS THE SIDE DOOR(S) WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE BAR AND THE ENTIRE TEAM WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE WITH THAT PLAYER, THEREBY FORFEITING ALL POINTS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TEAM MATCH.
